A study shows that: 94% of Taiwanese eat at least one snack every day. Snacking is more popular than ever. Some people believe snacks are healthy while others think they can be bad for your health. If you fall in love with snacks, you should be worried about your health. However, a healthy snack can give you nutrition. From this, to choose a healthy snack is very important for us.

Fruit, yogurt, cheese, boiled eggs, and nuts are examples of healthy snacks. It's best to eat snacks about 200 calories to help you stay full until your next meal. You had better get out of the way of processed and high-sugar snacks like chips, candy, or cakes. They may give you energy, but you'll probably feel hungrier an hour or two later.

You also need to know when to snack. When there is a long time between two meals, and you are really hungry, a healthy snack between meals can be a good idea. For example, if your lunch is at 1 p.m., but you won't get home in time to have dinner before 8 p.m., have a healthy snack around 4 or 5 p.m. If you have right snacks, snacking can be a healthy habit and may help you control your weight.

The Tao people, also known as the Yami people live on Orchid Island ("Lanyu" in Chinese), about 78 kilometers to the southeastern coast. They are thought to have come to Orchid Island about 1,000 years ago from the Batan Islands of northern Philippines. There are about 4,000 people live on the island.

Every year, when the Black Current comes to the East Coast, it brings rich fish for the Tao. That is why they believe that these fish are gifts from the Gods. From March to October, because flying fish can be easily caught, the Tao begin to celebrate the Flying Fish Festival.

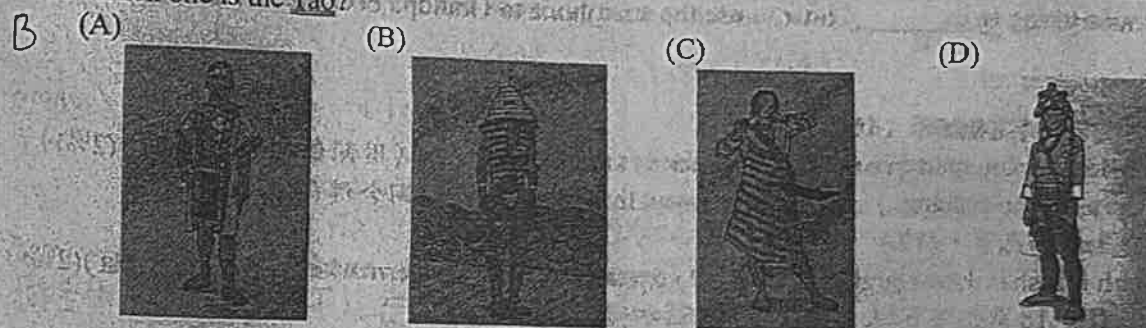
There are three seasons during the festival. The first one is the flying fish opening season. Only the men wear loincloth, silver helmets, and gold pieces, and face the sea to pray for a rich

catch.

The second one is the flying fish season. Held around June or July, it is close to its end. The third is the end of the flying fish season. They should finish catching flying fish, and dry flying fish. In this case, there will always be flying fish to eat in the future. Outside the flying fish season, the Tao men cut trees and build houses and boats. Boats are made of wood and are painted red, white, and black. The boat usually has human figures, waves, and the red and black circles and sun rays.
