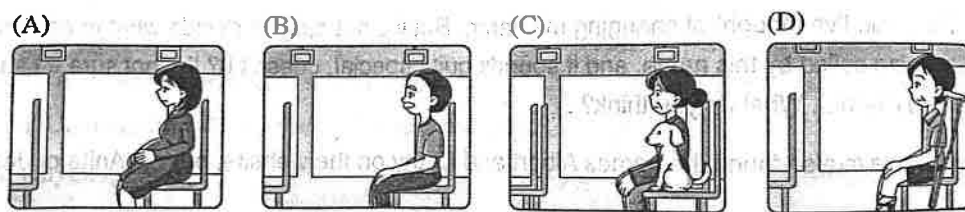

In recent years, Americans have designed the New Food Pyramid to teach people how to eat healthily from a greater variety of foods. The old food pyramid used to have only four food groups. But the new one now has six groups to meet the needs of most people.

Some people think that the New Food Pyramid is better than the old one because people can change the amount of food they can have based on their own needs. The old pyramid with fixed amount of food does not work for everyone. In fact, what kind of and how much food people should have depends on their living and exercise habits. It also depends on whether they are trying to lose or gain weight. The New Food Pyramid has a range of suggested servings of different kinds of food. If a person is trying to gain weight, he or she should eat the highest amount in the range. For those who want to lose weight, they should have the lowest amount. With the New Food Pyramid, people can make their own meal plans. However, to have the most suitable diet, it is better for you to ask the doctor for opinions.

There are over 5,400 types of mammals in the world. (16) 1500 C.E., about 80 animals have gone extinct. Animal saving work can be used to (17) animals. Animals are put on the endangered list if the number of living animals gets too small or the place where the animals are used to is taken. Three of Taiwan's endangered animals are the Formosan black bear, the Taiwan leopard cat, and the sika deer.

The Formosan black bear (18) on the endangered list since 1989. They are still hunted so there are no more than 300 bears left in Taiwan. Two kinds of wild cats (19) live in Taiwan, but now only the leopard cat survives. Farmers' hunting and use of weed killer are responsible for the fewer number of leopard cats. There are fewer than 500 left alive. The last sika deer seen outside of a cage was in 1969. The deer was raised by zoos and farmers. The population increased and in 1994 several hundred were set free into national parks. Now, (20) more than a thousand deer living in Taiwan.

These cases show that Taiwanese people can help save these mammals and maybe even more animals in the future.
