




A Cookie You Cannot Eat

There are many kinds of cookies we can see every day: chocolate, butter, and strawberry. However, there is another kind of cookie known as the HTTP cookie that we see every day but can't be eaten.

The HTTP cookie is a piece of information that your computer keeps. This information identifies you when you visit a new website. When you visit the website again, the cookie sends information about your last website experience. For example, if you shop online, the items in your shopping cart will stay there even after a few days. That's because the cookie will remember your information and send it to the website.

The cookie is made to make the online experience better for both the website owners and users. With cookies, you can see advertisements that fit your interest. This is because cookies save the information about the websites you visited and allow the advertisements to pop up when you visit other websites.

Cookies may also come with a bad side. Some people use cookies to steal personal information. There is a kind of bad cookie called the zombie cookie. It stays in your computer without you knowing about it and comes back even if you try to cross it out. Just remember, while cookies are very convenient, you must be careful with your personal information!
