In Turkey, the traditions concerning coffee are an important part of the nation's culture. Coffee was introduced to Turkey in the sixteenth century during the Ottoman Empire. And the coffee's brewing method has stayed the same to this day.

To make Turkish coffee, you need freshly roasted coffee beans, which are ground into

a fine powder. 46 Next, the small pot is put in hot sand until the coffee begins to foam. Just before it boils over, the pot is removed from the sand, and the coffee--grounds and all--is poured into tiny cups.

This process makes Turkish coffee quite strong, which is one reason that people usually have a glass of water with their coffee. 47 This quality of Turkish coffee makes it suitable to enjoy with sweets, which is why the hot drink is commonly enjoyed with treats like Turkish delight.

Enjoying coffee socially is a key element of Turkish culture. For example, after becoming engaged, a woman will serve her fiancé and his parents coffee. 48 To show he's ready to marry the woman, the man must finish his coffee without making any complaints or funny faces.

Turkish people say that "a good cup of coffee will be remembered for 40 years." This saying is based on an old story about a Turkish coffee seller. One day, he served a Greek captain some delicious coffee. Forty years later, when Turkey and Greece were at war, the coffee seller was captured. 49 After so many years, the captain still remembered the coffee seller as a friend.

In 2013, Turkish coffee became the first drink to be included by UNESCO as part of its Intangible Cultural Heritage list. 50 If you ever have the chance, try some and get a memorable taste of Turkish culture.

Yet, if you don't sleep for a long time, more than just your test scores may suffer. It is reported that a 17-year-old high school student, Randy Gardner, stayed awake for 264 hours, or 11 days. He did so as an experiment in order to study how he would behave without sleep. His eyes lost focus on day two. Then his ability to identify\* objects was gone, and he became moody and clumsy. By the end of the experiment, he had trouble concentrating, memorizing, and distinguishing\* between reality and fantasy. Although he recovered with no psychological or physical damage, the results could have been fatal\*.

According to sleep experts, humans need to sleep to clear the waste products in their brains. When awake, we use up our energy sources and these sources get broken into various by-products\*. As these chemical by-products build up, they increase the urge to sleep. If they are not cleared away, they can overload the brain. Accordingly, many negative symptoms\* of sleep deprivation\* arise.
