- 10% : the customer wasn't satisfied with the service;  
 15% : the service was acceptable;  
 20% : the service was quite satisfactory;  
 25% or above : the service was unparalleled.

Most people could live without food for ten days, but many would die after just three days without water.

We all know it is important to drink enough H<sub>2</sub>O. But, just how much water do we need every day? Are we really drinking enough water to stay healthy?

Generally, health experts tell us that we should be drinking 6 to 8 cups of water a day. Not everyone's cup, however, is the same size. Nor does everyone need the same amount of water. People with different weights, for example, need different amounts of water. Here are some tips on when and how much water to consume every day:

**Daily Water-Drinking Guide**

- ★ How much you should drink: Your weight (in kg.) x 30 = total amount (in ml.)
- ★ Tea and coffee don't count.
- ★ Drink more when you exercise or sweat a lot.
- ★ Drink regularly and evenly; don't drink over 1,000 ml. within an hour.
- ★ Don't wait until you feel thirsty to drink water. It might just be too late.
