

That's surprising. I've never heard about this. By the way, a new study I read found that there is a higher level of a "language protein" in the brains of girls aged 4 to 5 than in the brains of boys of the same age. Is it why girls learn to speak earlier and more quickly than boys?

Well, until now, only a little is known about the language protein, Foxp2. It will need more careful studies. It's true that girls do speak more words than boys, but only until they are twoand-a-half years old. After that the difference is very small.
