- ✗Check the author and source. Check the web address for the page you're browsing. Research the author to see ___35___ they are real and credible or not.

✗Check other sources. ___36___ Professional news companies have editorial guidelines and many resources for fact-checking, so if they are also reporting the story, that's a good sign.

✗Check the facts. Credible news stories will include plenty of facts-data, statistics, quotes from experts, and so on. If these are missing, question why.

✗Check the language. Fake news usually has a lot of spelling mistakes. Important news companies pay attention to the language of the news stories they report.

✗Look for other signs. Some fake news is published for fun. The ___37___ of the story is made to look interesting to readers, to make readers click on it. Sometimes just by skimming the headline, people can determine if it is fake news.

Fake news is so dangerous that it can easily affect important decisions. Readers should always stop, question, and check before believing or sharing a story they read online.

Fruit flies are very small insects and they love ripe or rotting fruits and vegetables. The flies eat the fruit, and they lay their eggs there. One fruit fly can lay up to 500 eggs on a piece of fruit. In eight days, the fruit flies that are born from these eggs will grow up as full adults that can then lay their own eggs. As you can see, what might start out as a small fruit fly problem can become very large very quickly.

There is a chance fruit flies can carry germs on to your food, but this seldom happens. Fruit flies are annoying, but they may not hurt you. However, because they are such a **nuisance**, most people want to get away from these small bugs as quickly as possible. Some people use pesticide to kill the flies, but it will also spread poison all over your kitchen. Luckily, there is a safe way for you to get away from fruit flies in your house.

The first step is to take all fruits or vegetables away from your table. Put these in the refrigerator or in boxes. Take out the trash. Wash dirty dishes in your kitchen. Doing all of these things will stop new fruit flies from finding food or places to lay their eggs.

Next, make a trap to catch all of the fruit flies in your house. First, fill a small bowl with 2-3 spoons of vinegar. Then, put a piece of very ripe or rotting fruit into the vinegar. Cover the bowl with a piece of plastic wrap and make very small holes in the wrap with a fork. If all goes according to plan, the flies will enter the trap through the holes but can't fly back out. This trap will catch all the fruit flies. You can kill these flies or let them fly outdoors.

Fruit flies can be annoying insects, but they do not have to make you crazy. With a few steps, you can get flies out of your house and stop new ones from taking over your kitchen.

Parents who have a child with autism need to find ways to support the child and help them grow socially and emotionally. It often requires hard work and sometimes just doesn't lead anywhere.

Great news for worried and tired parents of autistic children aged 5 to 10—Moxie, a social home robot, will soon be available on the market. This 30-cm-tall robot, with a round head and big green eyes, is specifically designed to assist these children.

What makes Moxie special? When interacting with autistic children, it engages by making direct eye contact, reading their facial expressions, holding conversations, and teaching them something interesting each day. Through Moxie, children can engage in activities like reading, drawing, and participating in missions, such as writing kind notes for their family to discover or sharing their feelings with friends, all aimed at improving their social skills.

Moxie is friendly and helpful, ensuring that children rarely get bored. However, it is not able to work ceaselessly. If a child becomes overly engaged with it at a time, Moxie gets tired and goes into sleep mode.

Moxie sounds like a dream social robot for families with autistic children, doesn't it? You may be curious about the cost. It is priced at \$1,699, with an additional \$60 monthly fee. While not cheap, it's important to remember that Moxie is not a toy. It will become a tool for autistic children to learn to express their feelings and get along with their family and friends.
