The Oxford Committee for Famine Relief, known as "Oxfam," was founded in Oxford in 1942. It raised money from __41__ people to help starving women and children in Greece during World War II. The charity experienced __42__ growth from this small beginning, becoming the world's most famous charitable organization.

After the war, Oxfam continued its work due to the __43__ in Europe. The war left millions of homeless __44__. They desperately needed food and __45__ during the cold winter months. In 1947, Oxfam opened its first shop in Oxford to raise money. It sold gifts and accepted items from the public to sell. The organization advertised in national newspapers to raise public awareness and encourage contributions.

In the 1960s, when the situation in Europe became more stable, Oxfam turned its attention to __46__ the needs of people in developing countries. The charity offered food, medicine, and clothing to help millions of poor people struggling to survive. From the 1970s onward, the charity opened hundreds of new shops in the UK and abroad. It advertised on TV to __47__ information about world emergencies, such as the Ethiopia famine in the 1980s.

The charity began to work with groups from other countries. In 1995, Oxfam International was formed, a global association of charities and organizations across __48__. Oxfam continues its work in the 21st century. Its __49__ is "The power of people against poverty." This charity has become a __50__ for organizations that wish to help people in need. They can obtain valuable experiences from Oxfam.

Once men started fighting, he jumped down into the middle of the battle, shouting with joy as Greeks and Macedonians fell around him. Athena, the goddess of wisdom, watched her half-brother Ares angrily; she believed that the Greeks were right to defend their land. 52 The Greeks ended up winning, and Ares never knew what had happened to him. After that day, a rumor began that the mighty god Ares had been defeated by a magical rock! Few people believed this rumor, but two Greek brothers found it interesting. These two young men owned the field on which battles kept happening, and it was difficult for them to grow crops with people fighting all the time. Therefore, they started collecting large stones. Their neighbors wondered if they were planning to build a wall to keep the Macedonians out. 53 They hid in the field for several nights before Ares showed up, looking to start another battle between the Greeks and Macedonians. The two brothers sprang into action and started throwing the stones at Ares. Magical or not, one of the stones hit Ares in the back of the head, and he was knocked out before he knew what had happened. The brothers quickly put Ares into a large pot, which they closed with a tight-fitting lid. Afterward, the field finally saw peace. 54 Ares was stuck in the pot for many years before his brother Hermes, the messenger god, finally rescued him. However, Ares never returned to the field, perhaps believing that the story about the magical rocks was true!

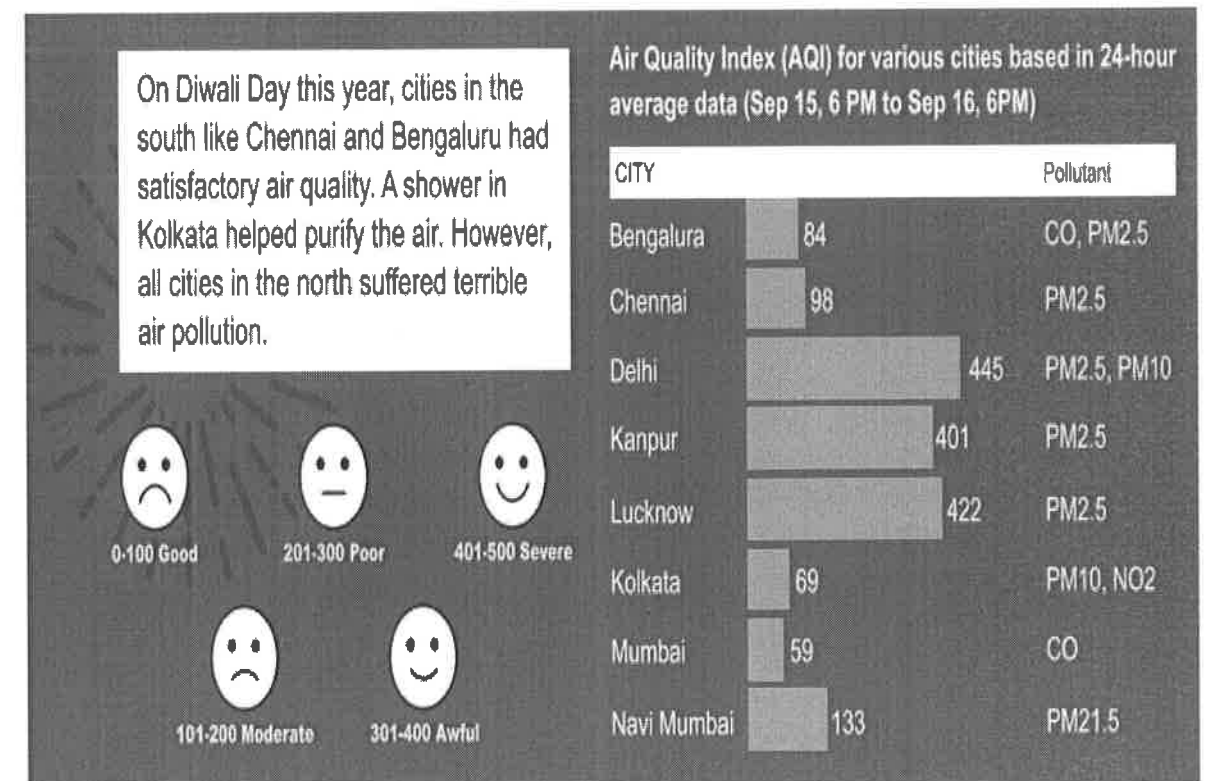
